In addition, prayers may also include Bishop David (the Suffragan Bishop) and, among the heads of other states, Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II and the leaders of other countries represented in the congregation.

At the moment, our concept of 'normal life' is badly disrupted by the effects of this virus and our governments' countermeasures to try to control its spread. In order to be real, I have listed them with a 'provisional' wording and, in each case, an invitation to pray for the work of the group, synod, etc. which would have been meeting. Our services might be interrupted but prayer never can be!
